<p>The <b>Master of Counselling</b> is a 48-credit point course which can be completed within 2 years of full-time study or part-time across 3-4 years. Entry to the Master of Counselling requires successful completion of the Graduate Diploma in Counselling. Applicants must provide an up to date CV and a brief written statement of up to 750 words (available online at <a href="https://mu-publishing-blob.azureedge.net/mu-publishing/mu-docs/librariesprovider4/default-document-library/personal-statement-template.pdf">https://mu-publishing-blob.azureedge.net/mu-publishing/mu-docs/librariesprovider4/default-document-library/personal-statement-template.pdf</a>). Our selection panel then interviews applicants to assess their suitability and readiness to commence with our training. Places in the Master of Counselling are limited.</p> <p>Students can choose between CSL677 (6 credits) or CSL620 (9 credits) if they choose CSL677 they need to take CSL674.</p>
