## Lesson Plan

- BEFORE projecting the slides Class Q&A:
  - Ask the students to raise their hands if they know what a Carnaby's Cockatoo is (don't ask them to describe this yet!). If no one puts their hand up ask if they know anything about 'Black Cockatoos' instead.
- Think-pair-share.
  - Ask students to think about Carnaby's Cockatoos, and bring to their mind all the things they know about them, or if they do not know what a Carnaby's Cockatoo imagine what they think it might be.
  - After a minute or two ask students to share (in pairs or small groups), write them down
    with a partner and then get them to create a brainstorm/mind map.
- Whiteboard/Report back
  - Get students to put their hands up and contribute to a class smartboard collection of all the ideas.
  - Identify what information is missing... what don't we (the class) know, and how will we find out?
  - Provide the students with NF-T1W Research Template OR NF-T1W Vocab Doodle Notes y3-7 worksheet
  - o Give out NF-T1R Fact-sheet-Carnaby's.pdf and/or go through the rest of the PPT with the class and ask the students to fill in the worksheet.
- Poster Creation
  - Students can then either use devices (e.g. Canva/Pic Collage demonstrating ICT capability) or A3 paper to create an informative poster to share what they have learned about Carnaby's Cockatoos.
  - The best work could be printed and put on display around the school.
