- Suitable/adaptable for Years 7 8 Science (Biology/Ecology)

Lesson Plan

- Project the slides *NF-T1P y7-8 The World of Carnaby's Cockatoo*. Ask the students:
 - What bird is this?
 - Ask if they know or have heard anything about Carnaby's Cockatoos. Which of these are Carnaby's Cockatoos?
- Learning activity WebQuest
 - In pairs students use devices to research about Carnaby's Cockatoos and fill in the boxes on the Worksheet *NF-T1W Research Template.pdf* If your class struggles with research based tasks you could provide the slides *NF-T1P y4-10 The world of Carnaby's Cockatoo* on your class one-drive or online learning platform for them to read.
- Learning activity Knowledge Sharing
 - Once they have found all the information needed to complete the research boxes students then use it to create either:
 - An informative poster about Carnaby's Cockatoo
 - An interesting presentation (max 5 minutes) using Powerpoint to teach others about Carnaby's Cockatoo
- Give students *NF-T2W_Word Search Quiz y7-9.pdf* to complete and test their knowledge. An easier version with word list (*NF-T2W Word Search Quiz y6-8.pdf*) is also provided.

Depending on the class you may wish to spread this over 2 periods and combine with a lesson on ecosystem function or habitat, or a session on scientific communication strategies. This lesson leads into Topic 2 (A Ngoolark Year: Seasons & Cycles) and Topic 3 (Home is Where the Habitat is).
