

Human Research Ethics Committee: Standard Conditions of Approval for exemptions.

- a) Anything which might affect the ethical acceptance of your project must be reported promptly, including:
 - Adverse events
 - Significant unforeseen events
 - Other matters that may impact the ethical acceptability of the project.
- b) Other Murdoch approvals (e.g. fieldwork approval) or approval from other institutions may also be necessary before the research can commence.
- c) Any equipment used must meet current safety standards. Purpose-built or modified equipment must be tested and certified by independent experts for compliance with safety standards.
- d) Research Ethics & Integrity must be notified of any changes to contact details including address, phone number and email.
- e) Graduate research degree candidates should also have Program of Study approval prior to commencing the research. Exceptions must be approved by the HREC.
