Request to Waive the 12 Month Application **Time Limit - Retrospective Withdrawal**





Requests for retrospective withdrawals (fee remission) must be made within 12 months of the withdrawal date or, for failed units, within 12 months from the end of the study period. The University may waive this requirement if it is verified that submission was not possible within this timeframe. Lack of awareness about the process or your HELP debt does not qualify as a valid reason to waive the application time limit.

This is not an application for a retrospective withdrawal. If your request to waive the 12-month application period is approved, you will then be asked to submit a separate application for retrospective withdrawal.
